Building Faith

Deut. 6:6

These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts.
Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home
and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.
Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads.
Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.

Ways to build faith

Let them "catch" you reading your bible

Regularly pray with them

Tell them your salvation story

Have them tell you what God is doing in their lives

Let them see you share your faith

Pray for the unsaved in your lives

Remind them of answered prayers

Building Character

Titus 2:7-8

Show yourself in all respects to be a model of good works,

Ways to build Character

Show respect & honor policemen & other authority
